AUTHOR CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

Agreement

This Consignment Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between The Lost Pages Bookstore, LLC ("the Store"), located at 2207 N. Kickapoo Ave., Shawnee, Oklahoma, and the author identified on the Consignment Intake Sheet ("the Consignor"). This Agreement governs the terms under which the Consignor's books will be displayed and sold at the Store.

1. Consigned Titles

The Consignor agrees to provide the Store with physical copies of the following title(s) for display and sale. It is recommended that the Consignor provide at least three copies of his/her title. Additional titles may be added by mutual agreement and documented on a separate Consignment Intake Sheet, which becomes part of this Agreement. Please document the consigned inventory on the Consignment Intake Sheet, either by printing the one online or one provided at the store location.

2. Revenue Split

When a consigned title sells, the proceeds will be divided as follows:

Consignor (Author)	60% of the retail cover price
The Lost Pages Bookstore	40% of the retail cover price

Example: A book priced at \$15.00 will result in a payment of \$9.00 to the Consignor and \$6.00 retained by the Store.

The retail price is set by the Consignor and must be clearly marked on each copy provided to the Store. The Store will not discount consigned titles without prior written approval from the Consignor.

3. Payment Schedule

- The Store will pay Consignors on a quarterly basis: March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31.
 - Payment will be issued by check or electronic transfer to the address or account on file.
 - A Consignment Sales Report will accompany each payment, listing titles sold and quantities during the payment period.
 - The minimum payment threshold is \$10.00. Balances below \$10.00 will roll over to the following quarter.

4. Inventory and Display

- The Store will make reasonable efforts to display consigned titles in an appropriate section of the store.
 - The Store is not obligated to display all copies provided at all times and may rotate stock as needed.
 - The Consignor is responsible for providing books in clean, undamaged, sellable condition. Books that arrive damaged will be returned at the Consignor's expense.
 - The Store will maintain a record of all consigned inventory received.
 - The Consignor may visit the Store during business hours to check on inventory and restock as needed, with reasonable advance notice.

5. Consignor Responsibilities

- The Consignor must provide books at their own cost. The Store does not purchase inventory upfront under this Agreement.
 - The Consignor is responsible for ensuring all titles are properly priced before delivery.
 - The Consignor agrees to notify the Store of any title going out of print or being significantly revised.
 - The Consignor agrees to promote their Store partnership on social media and in author communications where appropriate, including tagging The Lost Pages Bookstore when possible.

6. Unsold Inventory

- Either party may terminate this Agreement with 30 days written notice.
 - Upon termination or upon request, the Store will make unsold inventory available for pickup within 14 days of notice.
 - Unclaimed inventory after 30 days of notice will be considered donated to the Store unless other arrangements are made in writing.
 - The Store is not responsible for the cost of returning unsold inventory by mail unless otherwise agreed.

7. Loss, Damage, and Theft

The Store will take reasonable precautions to protect consigned inventory. However, The Lost Pages Bookstore is not liable for loss, theft, or damage beyond reasonable control, including fire, flood, or theft despite reasonable security measures. The Consignor acknowledges this risk and is encouraged to retain records of all inventory provided to the Store.

8. Author Events

The Lost Pages Bookstore welcomes and encourages author signing events and readings. Events are scheduled separately and are not governed by this Agreement. Consignors interested in hosting an event are encouraged to contact the Store to discuss availability and terms. Sales during author events will follow the same 60/40 revenue split unless otherwise agreed in writing for that specific event.

9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma. Any disputes arising from this Agreement shall first be addressed through good-faith communication between both parties.

10. Entire Agreement

By signing the Consignment Intake Sheet, both parties agree that this Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties regarding the consignment of the listed titles and supersedes any prior verbal or written discussions. Amendments must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
